Lewis' fourth comment here is very pertinent in helping you to assess the claims of Christ. Lewis also said that Jesus was either bad, mad or who he said he is!

Making the Best Connection is about discovering your Identity, Value and Purpose so you can live life to the full because Jesus can bridge the gap from you to God and from darkness to light. As the sun rises, so dark shadows take shape and we see the light of day.
